Options for Registering International Internships

1. Internships Abroad while participating in a Study Abroad Program
Offered on Selected Semester Programs
Internships as one of the five classes abroad
 - See Kevin Hayden in the Spiegel Center for Global and International Programs
2. Washington Internship Institute and Washington Center internships
Offered Summer, Fall and Spring
9 credit internship + 3 credit class
 - See Professor June Speakman in CAS 111 (E-mail: jspeakman@rwu.edu)
3. Disney College Program internships
Offered Summer, Fall and Spring
9 credit internship +3 credit class
 - See Rena Piller-Thurston in the CCPD
4. Independent internship abroad **for academic credit** secured on own/by student
Typically winter or summer session 3-9 credits
Independent international work experience
Follow the same add/drop deadline as regular classes
 - See Rena Piller-Thurston in the CCPD
5. International internships through an external provider (CEA, CIE, CIS Abroad, World Endeavors and others)
Typically winter or summer session 3-9 credits
Housing, additional class credits and program supervision may be provided
