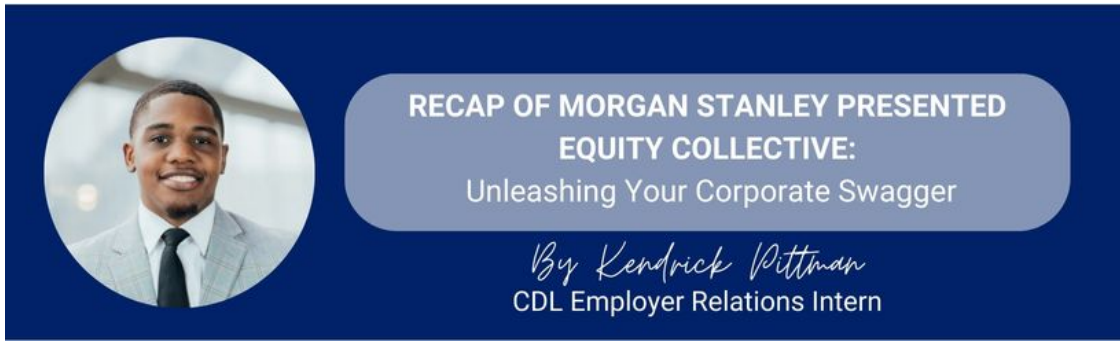

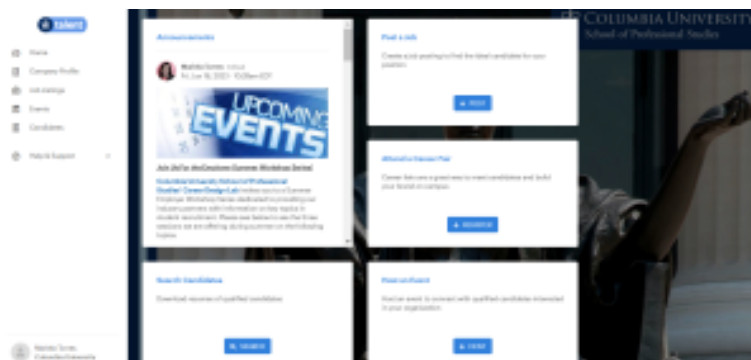

 - All Employer Sessions will provide you with a resume book of all registered attendees for your event.

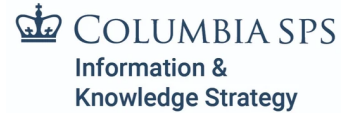
