

University of Rochester General Law School Data

The following information is University of Rochester recent graduate and alumni law school admission data from 2018 – 2023.

In 2023, the average national LSAT was a 155.9 and cumulative undergraduate GPA was a 3.61. For acceptance into the Top 10 schools, the minimum national LSAT score and cumulative GPA required were a 172 and 3.85, respectively.

The below data represents University of Rochester recent graduates and alumni application data over a five-year period (2018-2023) regarding LSAT score, cumulative GPA, number of applicants, and acceptance rate.

On average, 20 seniors and 49 alumni apply to law school each year, with most submitting between 5-6 applications. Applicants taking gap years attend law school, on average, 2-3 years after graduating with their undergraduate degrees.
