What is Available?

These are available in all rooms:

- Projector screen
- VGA Cable
- USB Connect

What Should I Bring?

The following accessories are NOT in the rooms. If needed for your presentation, you should bring your own:

- VGA Adapter
- Flash drive

Note: some laptops do not have a VGA port so a 'dongle' adapter is required. If this is the case, please bring your own.

If you have a Mac computer: please bring a display port to VGA adapter.

We highly recommend having a backup version of your presentation online or on a USB drive in the event of unplanned technical difficulties.

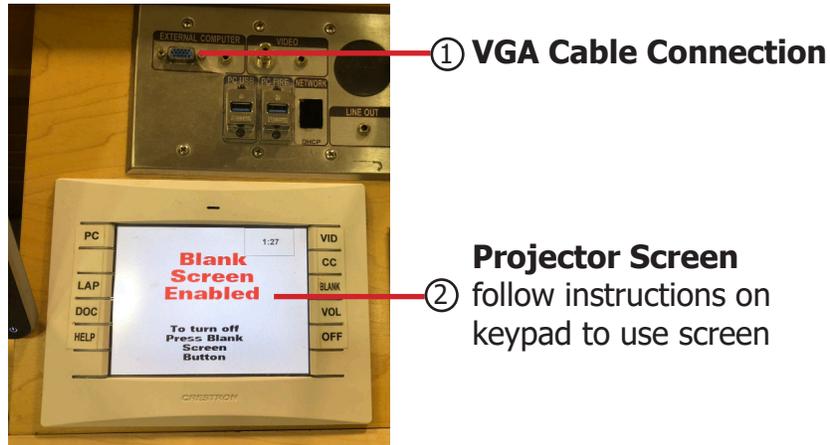
What If I Need Help?

Tech Tips

Directions for Using a Cable Accessory



Step 1: Plug cable into your computer and VGA cable port (1). If your computer only has an HDMI port, make sure you bring an HDMI to VGA adapter.

Step 2: Touch screen to turn on projector (2).

Step 3: Change source to laptop using buttons on side of screen (2).

Step 4: When finished with presenting, turn off system by using the 'System Off' button on the side of the screen (2).

Note: If you need audio, be sure to plug auxiliary cord into your computer as well.
