Admitted Students:

Once a student is qualified to receive the bachelor's degree or enrolls in the 13th credit of graduate course work, the student will be considered a graduate student for tuition billing, financial aid and enrollment identification, and will be eligible for graduate assistantships, fellowships, and loans.

Because of the wide range of total credits required in professional master's degrees (30-63), total credit-hour requirements for combined baccalaureate-professional master's degree programs can be approved on a range from 138 to 193 credits.

Launch your career as an information technology security analyst, cyber defense manager or risk manager in the private or public sector.

UAlbany's master's in digital forensics and cybersecurity will teach you how to rapidly detect and deter malicious network intruders and use special forensics tools to gather and analyze digital evidence.

The program is especially attractive to recent graduates with degrees in emergency preparedness, homeland security, cybersecurity, applied engineering, mathematics, and computer science. If you're an early- or mid-career working professional wanting to advance your career, you can finish the program part-time by registering for evening classes.

Choose from one of five concentration options: Cybersecurity; Cyber Operations; Digital Forensics; Risk, Policy & Compliance; or Health Security & Privacy.

PROGRAM

This program includes 30-33 credits of coursework over two semesters followed by a 3-6-credit summer internship or thesis in which you solve real-world problems.

You can complete this master's degree through full-time or part-time study. Evening classes are available to all students enrolled in the program.

The Master of Science in Business Analytics (MSBA) is a 30 credit program that can be done full-time in one year or on a part-time basis. This program is for students interested in learning the latest techniques for analyzing large data sets to gain business insights. It includes 27 credits of coursework over the fall and spring semester and a field research or consulting project worth 3 credits.

The MSBA program is suitable for recent undergraduate students, individuals changing careers and for those looking to upgrade their skill set to include the theory and practice of business analytics.

The program will provide students with the skillset to harness large datasets to more efficiently design effective business policies. Students learn techniques derived from various fields and gain practical skills on managing data that can be instantly applied and are useful across a wide range of business domains such as:

- Finance
- Marketing
- Accounting
- Retail
- Supply Chain
- Human Resources
- Management

REQUIREMENTS

Students entering the program are expected to have previous experience in quantitative analysis, Excel, and programming. Students who do not have previous experience in these areas will need to take the following admission deficiency courses:

- Quantitative Analysis for Business
- Advanced Excel with Visual Basic for Applications
- Advanced Programming

Decisions on the need for the above courses will be based on individual transcript review done during the admissions process or examination prior to coming to campus. Students will need to take applicable courses the summer before the start of the degree program.
