Fall

Spring/Summer

EDL 396B: Peer Mentorship and Leadership: Learn what it takes to lead a team on campus, in the community, and in the workplace. (3 credits)

Third Year: 6 credits



Fall

EDL 391/393: Team Leader/Internship: The most impactful experience within Blue Chip, leading a team of 15-20 first-year students. (2 credits)

Spring

EDL 391/393: Team Leader/Internship: the second semester as a Team Leader. students can also choose to be a Blue Chip TA or find an internship. (1 credit)
