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| :00 | 2 | Introduce Website <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Career Development & Vocation, which is part of CORE, has a website that we are going to spend some time reviewing | |
| :02 | 8 | Show website <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Point browser to careers.augustana.edu If possible, have them pull up the website themselves on their phones or laptops Navigate through each of the main tabs <ul style="list-style-type: none"> People We Serve (let them know that they'll review this as part of activity) Explore Career Paths: Share that we encourage students to think outside their major and think about their field of interest instead Build Skills : Point out <i>Explore Labor Insights</i> (let them know that they'll review this as part of activity), Share that there are resources for those planning on going to grad school as well as finding a job post graduation CORE: If time, point out all areas within CORE Viking Score (let them know that they'll review this as part of activity) Viking Connections (let them know that they'll review this as part of activity) Outcomes (let them know that they'll review this as part of activity) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Computer with screen Access to internet |
| :10 | 2 | Introduce Website Activity We are going to spend time digging deeper into specific areas within the website. Each of you will learn about a specific resource and then teach others. <i>You can easily adjust the number depending on the size of your group.</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Affinities/Identities: under <i>People We Serve</i> tab Candid Careers: yellow button on top right-hand corner Labor Market Insights: under <i>Build Skills</i> tab Outcomes: select <i>Outcomes</i> tab Viking Score: select <i>Viking Score</i> tab Viking Connections: select <i>Viking Connections</i> tab We are going to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Break into groups Each group member will choose the topic they want to explore, one per person All group members will research their chosen topic using their phones or laptops Move to groups with people researching the same topic and yours and learn from them Move back into home group and teach group members about your topic | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> One piece of paper for each group listing all of the topics you will be exploring |
| :12 | 3 | Begin Activity <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Get into groups of six (or fewer depending on group size), this will be your home group Review the list of topics, each group member chooses one topic they want to explore Does everyone have their own topic? | |

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| :15 | 6 | Research Your Topics <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Using your phones or laptops Go to the website, careers.augustana.edu Find your topic <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Affinities/Identities: under <i>People We Serve</i> tab Candid Careers: yellow button on top right-hand corner Labor Market Insights: under <i>Build Skills</i> tab Outcomes: select <i>Outcomes</i> tab Viking Score: select <i>Viking Score</i> tab Viking Connections: select <i>Viking Connections</i> tab You will have 4 minutes research your topic <i>Encourage them to take notes</i> Think about the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What is a 1-2 sentence overview of the topic? | :21 | 6 | Learn from others <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Move into groups by topic Indicate where each group is meeting up <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Affinities/Identities Candid Careers Labor Market Insights Outcomes Viking Score Viking Connections Share what you have learned about your topic <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Listen to what others with the same topic have learned Learn from each other and solidify your knowledge You will have 4 minutes to learn more <i>Encourage them to take notes</i> After 4 minutes, have them stop | |
