WHERE STUDENTS LEARN BY DOING

The Legal Clinic at PennWest provides students with a unique and valuable learning experience in the law, all under the supervision of a licensed practicing attorney. The Clinic provides legal services free of charge to clients who are unable to afford an attorney.

Students are engaged in actual legal cases, doing interviews with clients, researching the law, drafting various legal documents, and observing court proceedings.

Cases coming to the Clinic directly or by referral are screened. Cases are accepted only if they are appropriate for the best student learning experience. Once a case is accepted, the client must agree to hold the Clinic harmless and to permit student involvement.

Students may participate in Clinic activities in person or online, by zoom, or email.
