

# Add a class or academic project to your resume

## Add a class

- We suggest only adding classes to your resume if they are relevant to the job you are applying to and are **not common courses** that other students in your major take.
- **Only list advanced courses** or courses at the 300, 400, 500, or 600 level. Avoid intro and 100 level courses.
- For example: If you are a communications student seeking a position in marketing and completed marketing electives, include this in your resume.
- If you have not completed unique classes that are directly related to the job, consider focusing on your unique accomplishments to distinguish yourself from other students.
- Focus instead on your experiences and skills that make you a qualified and unique candidate, as opposed to listing classes that other similar candidates also complete.

If you choose to add classes to your resume, use one of the formats below.

**Educational** Create a new section labeled "Relevant Coursework"

If you have multiple relevant course categories that are relevant to the job, consider listing them in no more than 3 columns.

Consider alphabetizing your coursework

### Relevant Coursework

Technical writing, Business to Business marketing, Product Management, Logistical Sales

You may also consider listing all classes on one line with commas

Instead of listing courses alphabetically, consider listing classes based on relevancy to the job posting.

## Add a project

Academic projects are a great option to showcase your skills and career competencies. If you chose to add this to your resume:

- Only include professional, academic projects that provided you with relevant experience.
- Ensure the project aligns with the job posting that you are applying to.
- Review the job posting for the skills, experiences and knowledge that the employer is seeking. Highlight how you gained this through the project.
- Include 3-4 bullet points and thoroughly describe the project, your role and the skills you gained.

- Use 3-4 bullet points to describe the project, your role and the skills you gained.
- Coordinated communication efforts amongst group of 10 peers to ensure data collection was successful.
- Designed and implemented social media marketing campaign using brand storytelling to increase sales.

**Annotations:**

- Create a new section titled "Academic Projects"
- List Arizona State University as the company/ organization name
- List the months that you worked on the project
- List the project name in place of a job title
- Include 3-4 bullet points that describe your role
