Employer goal: To meet potential candidates from UC business schools and share employer information. Student Goal: To make a positive first impression and build rapport with the employer representatives. Learn insider information on the career path, industry trends, and company norms through your questions for the employer and their presentation.

Expectations for attending:

- This is an ON-CAMERA event that requires your full participation. Be in a private room or space where you can fully engage in the conversation. Dress professionally, arrive on time, and have several questions ready for the professionals and the recruiter. You represent Rady and your program, so please remember to smile, be enthusiastic, and kind to our guests.

- 3. What do they want applicants to know about before you enter the room?

4.	Ask thoughtful questions:

Be prepared to talk about the following:

- You: Why are you excited (interested) in _____ and the work they do? What led you to pick the program you are studying currently? What is an exciting or interesting skill set or class you are currently taking? See additional details on personal narrative on the CMC website.
- If introductions are done: Sample introduction format: Hi my name is ----- and I will be completing my MBA in June 2024. Appreciate you being here today.

Research Company: Ask Informed questions that demonstrate your interest in learning about the company. Review their website and industry updates that are available through IBIS World Industry Intelligence (via UCSD Library log into school VPN first) and CMC website. As important, visit the _____ website and view their jobs advertised on <u>12Twenty</u> for Rady School of Management students.

Recommended questions to ask:

Be prepared to ask a variety of informational questions to gain insights into the company, industry trends, and

potential career paths. Remember to tailor these questions based on your specific interests and the role you are seeking. Additionally, be sure to actively listen to the responses and engage in meaningful conversations to make a positive impression. See question samples by topic below:


