1. Business Formal

Business formal includes full suits with slacks, dresses, or skirts, collared shirts, blouses, ties, and close-toed shoes.



3. Smart Casual

Smart Casual is neat, conventional, and more informal. It includes dark jeans, boots, causal button up shirts & blouses, and leggings with long blouses or dresses.



2. Business Casual

Business casual includes nice bottoms (slacks, khakis, and skirts) and tops (sweaters, cardigans, blouses, polos, & collared shirts). It does not include jeans.

Casual includes jeans, comfortable shirts, blouses, and duck gear. Casual typically does not include sweats or workout gear in an office setting.
