

LinkedIn Profile Checklist

PHOTO: Make sure your photo is professional according to your field of interest. Follow some rules: Photo should be just you, shoulders and up, eyes looking at the camera, and not a selfie.

NAME: Some students choose to include their personal identifying pronouns next to their name. This is optional.

HEADLINE: Create a descriptive headline that is future-oriented and packed with keywords.

ABOUT: Communicate who you are, what you've done, and where you're going. Target your message towards companies, industries, and job functions vou're interested in.

EXPERIENCE: You can use the same bullet points you have on your resume or write short paragraphs using the WHO* method. Highlight projects, coursework, and volunteer work... not just jobs. Include photos, links to websites, videos or reports that you created.

*WHO method: get each bullet point, or paragraph to answer the questions: What did you do? How did you do it? Outcomes of your work?

ADD MEDIA: Show evidence of your work by adding documents, pictures, screenshots, links to blog posts or websites, and reports. Remember, get permission from your employer because some content may be proprietary.


