Using AI for Career Research and Preparation

Therefore, it is crucial to approach AI-generated content with a critical eye and assume that every statement involving facts and data could be a well-spun lie. Responses from AI tools are only as good as the prompts you provide it. To get the most out of the tool, use specific prompts and ask it to revise its answers.

- Take ownership of the changes these tools suggest so you are ready to talk about them in an interview.
- Remember, your documents, self-introduction, and interview answers still need to sound like YOU. AI can help get you started, but it is up to you to perform quality control on any information generated, re-write the content in your own words, and keep working with the tool and editing until you get a result that represents you and your brand.
