




The class of 2018 consists of graduates from undergraduate programs who were awarded degrees in July, August, December 2017 and May and June 2018.



OUTCOMES BREAKDOWN (80% Knowledge Rate)







OUTCOMES BREAKDOWN (75% Knowledge Rate)




OUTCOMES BREAKDOWN (72% Knowledge Rate)

OUTCOMES BREAKDOWN (73% Knowledge Rate)




AVERAGE STARTING SALARY


OUTCOMES BREAKDOWN (89% Knowledge Rate)


OUTCOMES BREAKDOWN (86% Knowledge Rate)


OUTCOMES BREAKDOWN (98% Knowledge Rate)

OUTCOMES BREAKDOWN (94% Knowledge Rate)


