Data Collection Methods


The Class of 2019 consists of graduates from undergraduate programs who were awarded degrees in July, Aug. and Dec. 2018 and May and June 2019.



Results reflect information on 2,861 of 3,330 undergraduate degree recipients, representing an 86 percent knowledge rate.
















