For more than 35 years, Seattle Rep's Professional Arts Training Program (PATP) has helped young professionals break into the world of not-for-profit arts.

INTERNSHIPS

We offer season-long Internships in:

- **Scenic Art (Paint)**
- **Properties**
- **Directing/Casting**
- **Directing/Literary**

All Internships are volunteer positions with a \$250 weekly reimbursement for expenses and opportunities for valuable, hands-on experience in their field. Interns also participate in seminars led by industry professionals, which offer an overview of how artists and departments collaborate at the regional theater level. Seattle Rep offers limited free housing opportunities for Interns.

APPRENTICESHIPS

We also offer season-long Apprenticeship opportunities in:
