Job Scavenger Hunt

Explore career options through investigating occupation titles and follow the instructions below to research and record important information about each occupation.

1. Go to <http://www.onetonline.org>
2. Hover over the "Find Occupations" header in the gray toolbar at the top of the page, and select "Career Cluster" from the drop-down.
3. Use the drop down menu to find a cluster that you want to explore (i.e. Business, Management, and Administration) and select "GO". This will pull up a list of occupation titles for you to explore. Click on the occupation title for additional information.
4. If you would like to explore other titles, you can type a specific job title in the "Occupation Quick Search" box in the upper right hand corner.
5. After reviewing the occupation titles, select 3 that you are interested in and record them under the "Occupation Title" boxes below.
6. Answer the following questions for each occupation selected job title. Reflect on your answer. What themes do you notice? Which title are you most drawn to? Make note of similar titles?
7. Schedule a meeting with a career counselor at the Career Management Center to continue processing – remember this is a journey – and the CMC is here to support you!
