Chat GPT, also known as Chat Generative Pre-Trained Transformer, is a natural language processing and artificial intelligence model that uses information pulled from the internet and deep learning to create “human-like text” through an interactive chat environment.

It is important to understand all the possibilities and setbacks that could come from using artificial intelligence for building your career platform. It is important to know that AI is constantly improving which comes with new opportunities and new challenges, as always be aware of the current environment in deciding whether to use AI during this process of career development. Please note that AI is still just a tool, and you should use it with caution. Please take the time to understand the pros of AI and how you can best use this tool as well as understand the cons of relying on AI and the weaknesses that currently exist.

General Pros and Cons

Pros / Uses

- Easy and convenient way to generate material related to career search
- Avoids human error in spelling and grammatical mistakes
- Time and Cost Effective
- Allows beginners a starting off point to start the writing process
- Can provide personalized feedback on documents and writing samples

Cons / Weaknesses

- Can lack specifics and personal attributes
- Uses similar language and ideas in most/all responses, creating a lack of individuality and creativity
- Easy for employers to recognize
- Is only effective if properly prompted- must know what to ask it
- Potential for AI bias
- May store conversations and account information, which is available to “Vendors and service providers, other businesses, affiliates, legal entities, and AI trainers who review your conversations” according to ChatGPT terms and conditions



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AI Resume

Pros / Uses

- A convenient way to save time when thinking about what to include for bullets
 - Utilizing AI can be an effective
- Chat GPT uses the same deep learning as most artificial intelligence, including software systems that are incorporated into applicant tracking systems. Therefore, there is a high likelihood that it will pass most initial screenings as long as the content is sufficient.
- Really well-written bullet points when prompted accurately
 - Ex: Prompt – Write me a resume section for my summer internship
 - Ex: Prompt – Write me a resume section for my tax and audit advisory internship in Boston at KPMG.

Note that this section includes the name of the company and location, the job title and timeframe, and 5-6 bullet points describing the responsibilities, achievements, and skills developed during the internship. It's important to tailor these bullet points to the specific internship and highlight relevant experience and skills that align with the job requirements.

Cons / Weaknesses

- It is not able to complete the resume without detailed instructions from the prompter/user
- Uses resume-writing tools from all over the internet, some of which might be outdated. It does not have the capability to decipher a good resource from a bad or outdated one, so it pulls all of them together
 - Ex). Utilizes an objective statement Puts periods at the end of all bullets
- Cannot produce a template or a document with an effective format, just text
- Puts periods at the end of all bullets
- Very generic and lacks creativity and personal style
- Will likely be similar, if not identical, to other candidates across the industry who use the platform, signaling to employers a lack of effort and dedication to the application process. 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AI Cover Letter

Pros / Uses

- Uses key terms or phrases from the job description
- Chat GPT can aid in the proofreading process, and eliminate the spelling and grammar errors that the human eye may not catch
- Provides a good starting point for students/candidates who may be unsure of where to start a cover letter.
- It can cross-reference a resume it made or a resume you provide to see where/how the user's experience can align with the job description.
- Very user friendly- feels like a text conversation
- Can generate multiple versions of the same cover letter to be specific to the job descriptions and user needs.
 - Ex: Marketing Internship at Epsilon vs. Investment Banking Analyst at JP Morgan

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AI Cover Letter Con't.

Cons / Weaknesses

- In studies and surveys, recruiters say the large majority of the time they can tell when AI produced a resume/cover letter.
- Same as above, less personality and style, which is especially harmful in cover letters as this is an opportunity to demonstrate to employers your ability to write professionally – specifically in business. Good business writing is a skill that must be developed, and employers want to see a candidate's ability to do so, which is why they ask for cover letters.
- Does not include writer's contact information
- Does not provide a "grabber statement" or any personal information about the company that shows why an individual would want to work there.
- Cannot really make the CL unique to the user and their strengths, which is vital especially in the opening paragraph.



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AI LinkedIn

Pros / Uses

- Generates custom hashtags related to the job post
- Follows a similar format to most LinkedIn job announcements
- Clear, concise announcements

Cons / Weaknesses:

- User has to edit it to include mentors or other individuals to thank

Examples:

Prompt- write me a LinkedIn post announcing i just received a full-time offer for compliance analyst at fidelity investments

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AI Interview Preparation

Pros / Uses:

- Allows users to get a general overview of what questions may be in an interview

Cons / Weaknesses:

- The questions provided are often generic and do not compare to other resources, such as Big Interview, for industry-specific questions
- Many of the questions are the same across differing industries and job titles
- Some questions are outdated
- Lacking technical questions

Examples:

Great, here are some potential interview questions for a marketing internship at Epsilon:

1. Why did you choose to pursue a marketing internship at Epsilon?
2. Can you tell me about your experience working on a marketing campaign or project?
3. How do you stay up-to-date on industry trends and developments in the marketing field?
4. Can you describe a situation where you had to think creatively to solve a problem?
5. How do you approach collaborating with a team on a project?
6. How do you prioritize and manage multiple tasks and deadlines?
7. Can you walk me through your experience with developing and executing marketing plans?
8. How do you measure the success of a marketing campaign or project?
9. Can you give an example of a time when you had to adapt to change in a project or campaign?
10. How do you approach working with cross-functional teams, such as sales or product, to achieve marketing goals?

Sure, here are some potential interview questions for an investment banking analyst internship program at JP Morgan:

1. Why are you interested in investment banking and JP Morgan specifically?
2. Can you walk me through your resume and highlight the experiences that have prepared you for this internship?
3. How do you stay up-to-date with current events and industry trends related to investment banking?
