6. What is an accomplishment you are most proud of?
7. What is your greatest strength and what is your greatest weakness?
8. Can you give me a specific example of how you approach a project? What is your method for planning an approach?
9. Do you prefer working in a team, or would you rather work as an individual?
10. Do you have any questions for me?
