COMPLETE THE FINAL SELF EVALUATION

At the end of the semester, the Career and Advising Center will administer a Final Self Evaluation via your NDSU email. This online evaluation must be completed by the deadline provided.

ENSURE YOUR SUPERVISOR COMPLETES THE FINAL EMPLOYER EVALUATION

At the end of the semester, the Career and Advising Center will send out an Employer Final Evaluation to your designated supervisor. This online evaluation must also be completed by the deadline provided. Please check in with your supervisor to ensure they have received this evaluation at the end of the term.
