

My qualifications for this role are as follows: Always follow the BAR format and incorporate stories that demonstrate accomplishments and skills.

- Strong business analytics expertise In my last role, I analyzed costs for a \$5M project and identified a 20K in savings by consolidating vendors.
  The cover letter should always address the top 4 or 5 skills in the job description.
  - Having bullets that speak directly to that will make them stand out. **Project Management** – As a senior analyst, I led several projects that created efficiencies and cut waste by approx. 16%. I oversaw the aggregation of data for a multi-million dollar data warehouse project.
- Building high performing teams In my last role, I built and led a team of 4 analysts to aggregate customer data and successfully demonstrate the need for a new CRM platform.

This paragraph should summarize how well you would fit, convey your genuine interest, and thank them for their time. As with all the other paragraphs, this one should be four to five lines maximum. In many cases, you can get away with having only three lines in this paragraph. It makes it easier to read.
