

RECRUITING RECEPTION VS. CO-OP & CAREER FAIR

What's the difference between Wentworth's Recruiting Reception and the Co-op & Career Fair? See the list below for what to expect from each type of event & for guidance to make a great impression.

Recruiting Reception	Co-op & Career Fair
➤ Employers are not stationed at a table	➤ Employers have a dedicated booth
➤ There will be no signs indicating employers	➤ Employers have signs at their booth
➤ There will be one or two tables for all employers to leave written materials at the entrance to the tent	➤ Employers have their materials at their dedicated tables.
➤ Employers and students are encouraged to mingle anywhere under the tent and on the quad	➤ Employers typically stay at their booths
➤ There will not be a map that indicates where employers are located	➤ There is a map and booth numbers
➤ What to wear: business casual	➤ What to wear: business attire.
➤ Food and beverages for everyone will be readily available	➤ Food and beverage is not usually available to students
➤ A reception mimics events students will most likely attend once they are working	➤ The Fair is a specific event that most people no longer attend once they are working
➤ All employers are required to have jobs and/or co-ops posted in WITworks	➤ All employers are required to have jobs and/or co-ops posted in WITworks
➤ Weather permitting, this is an outdoor event	➤ This event is held inside the gym
➤ There is no headshot station available	➤ A photo booth for headshots is traditionally available
