Do you have a meeting, business presentation, or job interview?

- We recommend you wear a Black suit.
 If you only have neutral colors (dark
 gray, navy, brown) okay as long as top
 and bottom are matching.
- Skirt suits recommended; skirts should be a little below the knee and never shorter than above the knee
- Pressed, collared button-down shirt
- Dress shoes (pumps, flats, heels) No platform or >2.5 inch heels
- Make-up should be minimal and conservative (daytime makeup)
- Keep hair and jewelry simple
- Please no perfume or body sprays





- Dress to impress by wearing a full suit with matching jacket & pants with black belt
- Pressed, collared shirt with plain (solid, stripe, or simple pattern) tie
- Dark leather dress shoes and dark dress socks
- A tie should never be too long or too short
- mismatched pants & jacket are not recommended.
