

Compass Career Path

How does this look for students?

- The Career Path consists of four modules meant to reflect actions students should take each of their four years at St. Kate's
 - Excite (First year)
 - Explore (Second year)
 - Engage (Third year)
 - Emerge (Fourth year)
- Compass Career Path launched in Fall 2021, focusing on first year CFW students

1st Year CFW students were prompted to complete the following activities through their TRW lab sessions

- 5. Introduced to using LinkedIn to find and connect with alumni mentors




Bring it up in your day to day interactions




