TOPIC: NETWORKING & LINKEDIN

Learning Objectives

- Introduce students to the practice of online networking. •
- Provide students with information about LinkedIn and how to set up their own profile. Note: Students should bring personal devices to class to work on individual profiles.
- Demonstrate several resources available on LinkedIn and how LinkedIn can function as a powerful networking tool.

Core Concepts

Dysfunctional Belief: "You should focus on your need to find a job." Reframe: "You should focus on the hiring manager's need to find the right person."

Possible Activities

should be a snapshot of their story. After you have given your students a few minutes to consider their own pitch, pair everyone up with a partner and have them practice delivering it. After a few minutes, switch partners. Do this for several rounds so that students get the chance to see what others say in their pitch.
