
HOLLAND CODE: WHAT IT MEANS

Realistic (Doers): people who have athletic ability, prefer to work with objects.

Investigative

(Thinkers): people who like to observe, learn, investigate, analyze, evaluate, or solve problems.

Artistic (Creators): people who have artistic, innovative, or intuitional abilities. like to use their imagination and creativity.



The Holland Code is based on Dr. John Holland's theory that people and work environments can be loosely classified into six different groups. See our "Guide to Holland Code" for more information!

Social (Helpers): people who like to work with people to enlighten, inform, help, train, and teach.

Enterprising (Persuaders): people who like to work with people, influencing. leading, or managing for organization goals or economic gain.

Conventional (Organizers): people who like to work with data, have clerical or numerical ability, and carry out tasks in detail.



- Displays what is important to you in your work and life. These results match with occupations you may find satisfying, based on similarity between your work values and those associated with occupations.
- Identifies your talents and the types of things you easily learn and/or perform proficiently. A skill can be acquired through education, experience, or training as well as the result of a natural ability.
- Recognizes the kinds of leisure related activities you most enjoy doing and how this might fit in with your career and life planning.
