

Walt Disney World College Program Non-Credit Enrollment Form

Students who wish to participate as interns in the WDW College Program must first speak with their academic/faculty advisor to see if they can earn any academic credit for the experience. Students who cannot earn enough academic credit to be considered full-time enrolled at the institution (12 credit hours) must register for a zero credit hour Disney Internship course (SSC 1500) or Disney Advanced Internship course (SSC 3100). A permission number will be granted by Amanda Nell (MU Career Center) once the student speaks with her/his academic advisor and completes the following form. Note: If you do not register for this course you will be un-enrolled from the University of Missouri.

Students should take the following steps prior to leaving campus for the WDW College Program:

1. Disney courses are rarely accepted for credit so speak with your academic advisor about how you can make up those academic credits (summer school, online courses, transferring Disney credit through another institution) or if you will simply delay graduation by one semester.
2. Speak with your academic advisor about making arrangements for class registration for the following semester and the courses you should take. Keep those registration dates in mind and be checking your Mizzou email account while interning off-campus.
3. Make sure that you talk with your financial aid advisor to determine if your aid (scholarships, grants, loans, etc.) will be affected.
4. Double check policies with your health insurance provider - most just need to see proof of enrollment and you will be considered academically enrolled at MU while on the WDW College Program as long as you are registered for SSC 1500 or SSC 3100.
5. Address what your departure will mean for your living arrangements. That may mean finding a person to sublease your apartment, canceling a Residence Life contract, etc. Residential Life will cancel your contract without penalty which will also terminate your Campus Dining meal plan.
