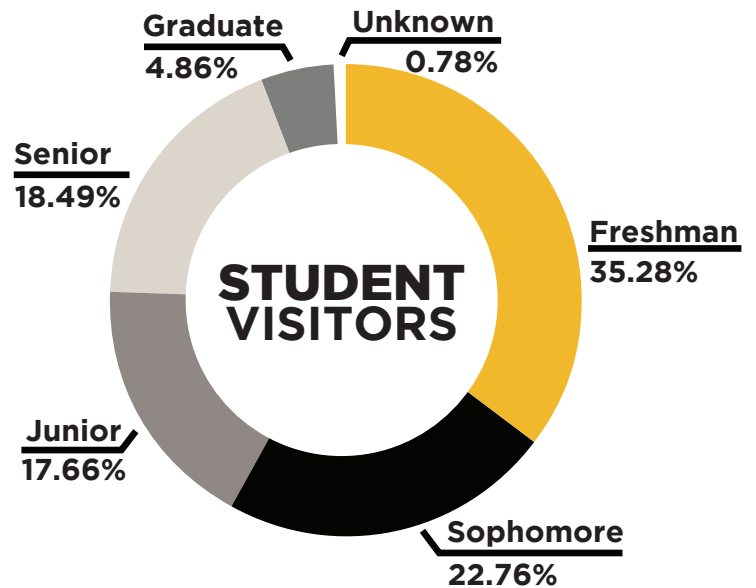
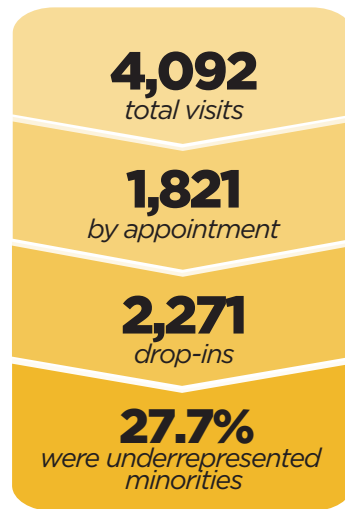

EXPLORATION

Empower students to envision and clarify goals through career exploration and self-development.

Career Center Courses:

320 Incoming students enrolled in **17 sections** of **SSC 1150 Discover** course.

63 students enrolled in **SSC 2100 Career Explorations** class to assist in their career "decidedness."

2,562

New users logged into Focus 2 to evaluate their career interests and career readiness.

381

Counseling sessions provided by career counselors.

3,815

CliftonStrengths assessments taken by MU students, faculty, & staff through the MU Career Center.

EXPERIENCE

Advocate for and model rich student employment and experiential education to engage students, increase persistence and support their success.

CAMPUS EMPLOYMENT:

1,360 students enrolled in the online course, *Navigating Student Employment at Mizzou*.

826 lapel pins and certificates were distributed to graduating students for commencement.

PREPARATION

Coach students to actively prepare for and successfully pursue their unique career paths.



A&S Coaching conducted 71 student appointments:

- Majority of meetings were with seniors.
- 35.2%** of visits were by First Generation students.
- 29.6%** career exploration; **43.6%** general career guidance and **26.8%** job search.

Big Interview

Nearly **3,500** students logged to record **27,020** interviews.

Students also completed **840 assignments** on the platform for their instructors.

JUMPSTART:

107 tutors provided **36,000** hours of service, helping pre-school children become kindergarten ready.

employers attended 12 career fairs to connect with students.

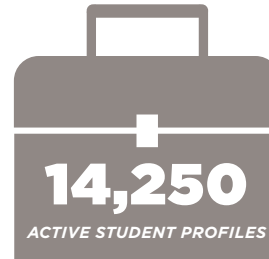

Career Development Network

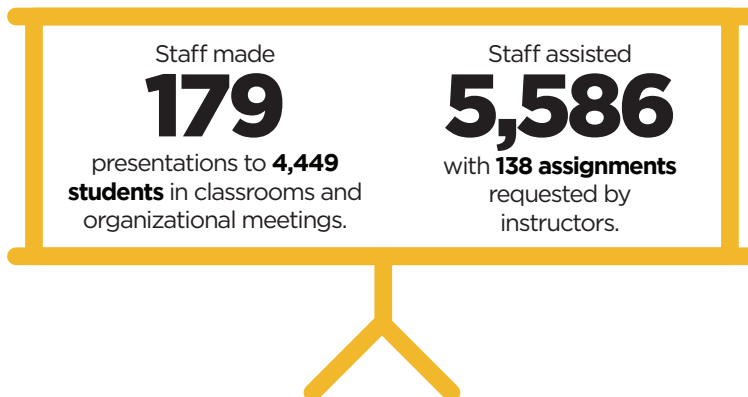
24 participants participated in a 4-day training intensive for new career services professional and graduate assistants.
