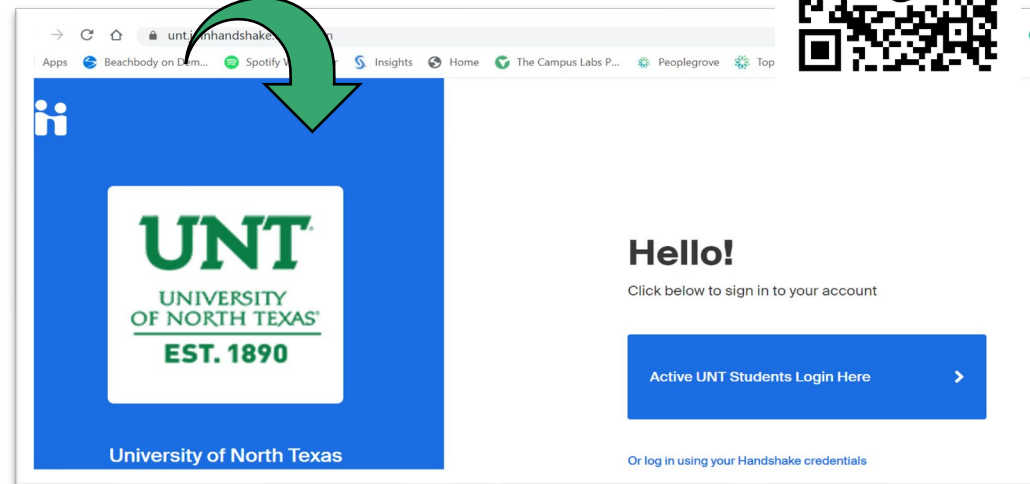

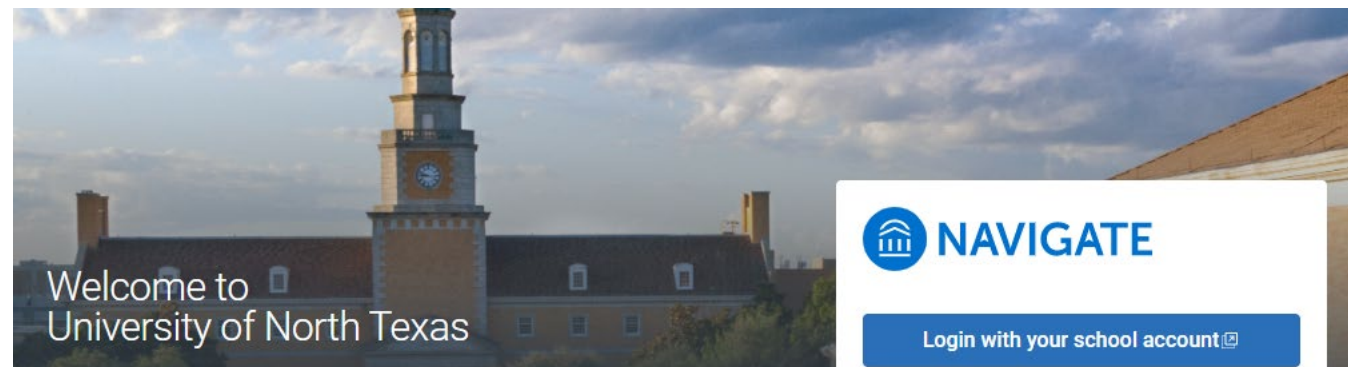

 - Liberal Arts & Social Science (CLASS) majors – choose between UCRS 2100 and UCAR 1000Z
 - College of Education Teacher Candidates – EDEC 1010 and EDEE 1010
 - New College Project Design & Analysis majors – SPDA 2010
