The TXWORKS Internship Program is a statewide initiative that connects Texas undergraduate students with employers through paid internship opportunities. Employers participating in the program receive periodic reimbursements for a portion of the interns' hourly wages throughout the internship period. TXWORKS offers companies a valuable opportunity to strengthen their talent pipeline, engage with emerging professionals, and help shape the future workforce by fostering essential career competencies in student interns.
