Become a Career Champion By enrolling as a Career Champion, you have access to resources and training on career development best practices. The time commitment for the program is flexible.

Incorporate career development into your curriculum

Utilize self-paced, student-facing, customizable Career Development modules or work with our <u>Program Designer, Kaitlyn Anderson</u>, to customize for your course, syllabus, or assignments.

Align Career Competencies

Work with Kaitlyn Anderson to highlight <u>NACE career</u> <u>competencies</u> and career development opportunities with course objectives and class assignments.

Assessing Career Readiness Invite your students to take the Am I Career Ready? assessment in Focus2 to gauge their current proficiency with career competencies and have them determine if and how they might enhance specific competencies during your course.

Become a mentor in HuskyLink Sign up as a mentor on <u>HuskyLink</u> and share your insight, advice, and perspective with UConn students and alumni.

Request a classroom presentation from the Career Center
