

CAREER PLANS SURVEY

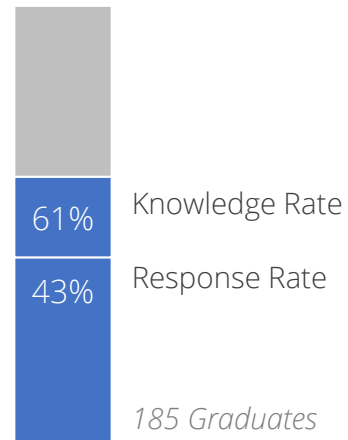
School of Nursing, Undergraduate Class of 2018



Methodology

Career Services at the University of Pennsylvania annually surveys graduating students to provide a snapshot of their post-graduation plans.

This report looks at School of Nursing undergraduates who received their degrees from August 2017–May 2018. Students were surveyed up to six months from their graduation date. Of the total 113 responses, 70% came from online/phone surveys and 30% came from LinkedIn and other online sources.

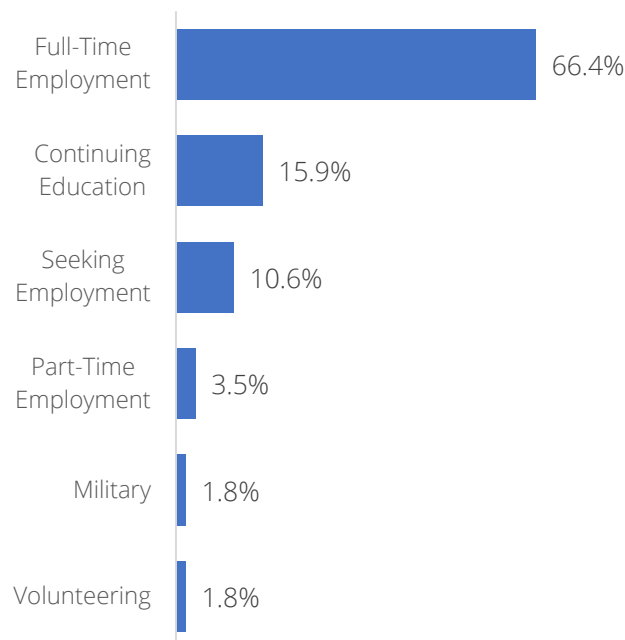


Summary

- 70% of respondents were employed full or part-time, with a median full-time salary of \$65,000.
- 49% of respondents accepted positions in Pennsylvania.
- The University of Pennsylvania was both the top employer and top school for continuing education.

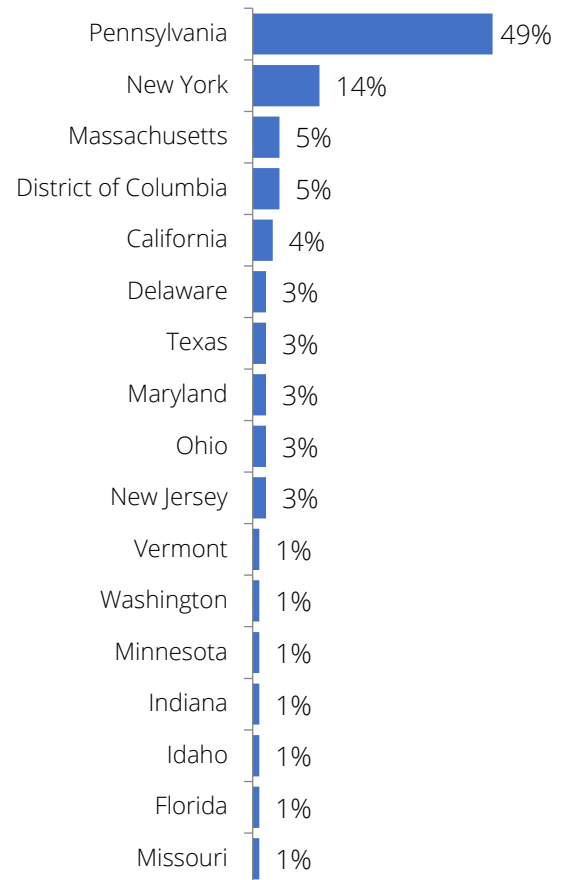


Summary

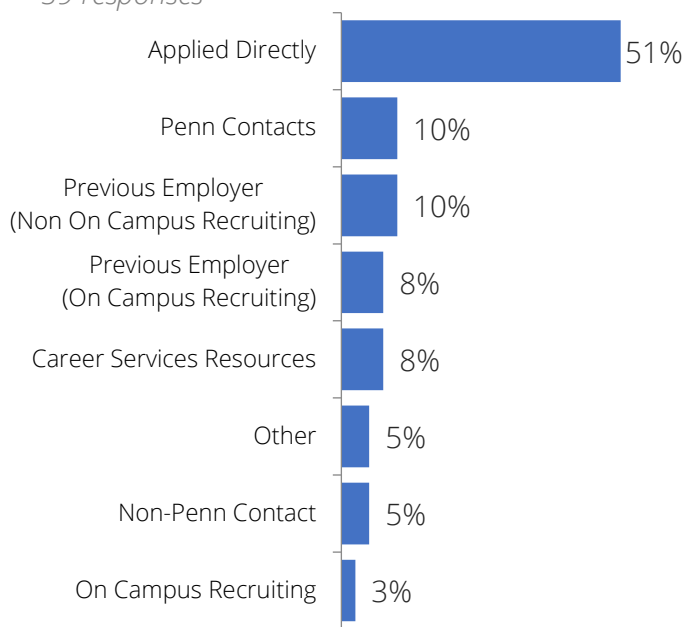
Where Their Job Is Located

74 responses



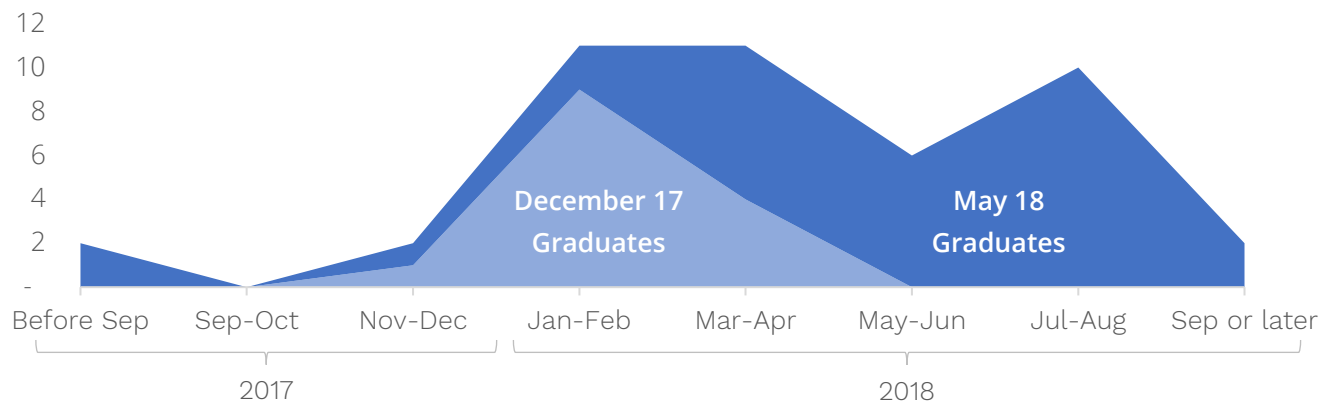
How They Got Their Job
