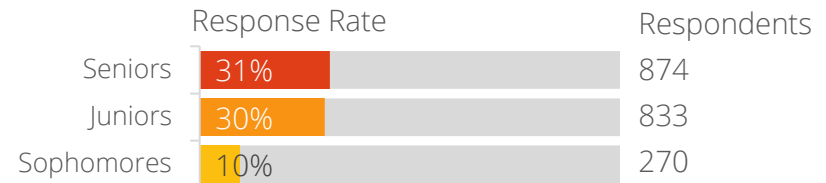


2018 UNDERGRADUATE SUMMER SURVEY



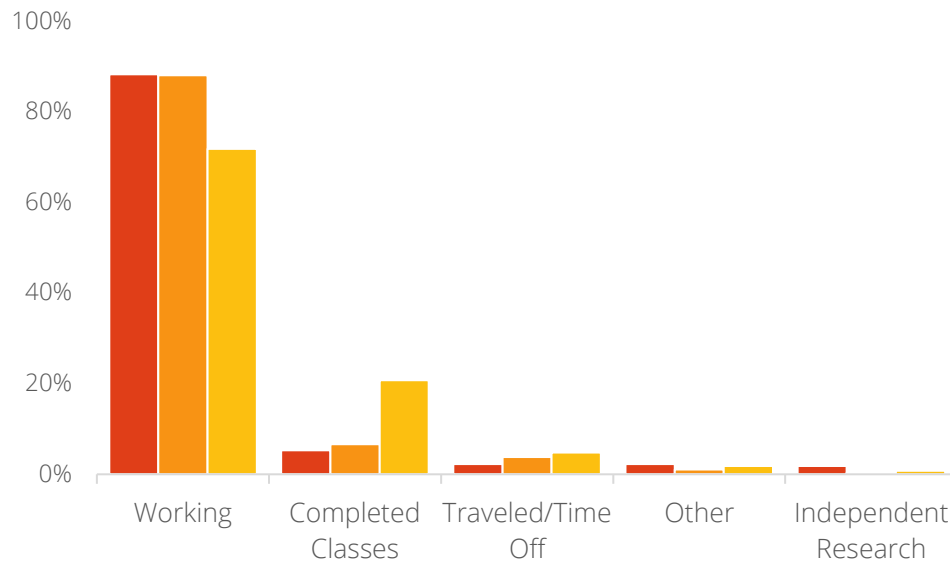
Career Services at the University of Pennsylvania annually surveys undergraduates to provide a snapshot of their summers. This report looks at rising sophomores, juniors, and seniors during summer 2018. Undergraduate students were sent an online survey during the summer and fall of 2018 about their experiences.



Primary Summer Activity

1,976 responses

- Rising Seniors** were primarily working (88%).
- Rising Juniors** were primarily working (88%).
- Rising Sophomores** were working (72%) or focused on classes (21%).



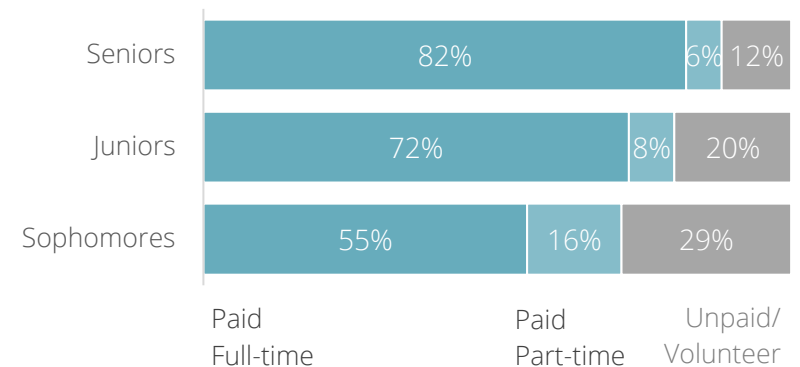
Average Monthly Salary

1,669 responses

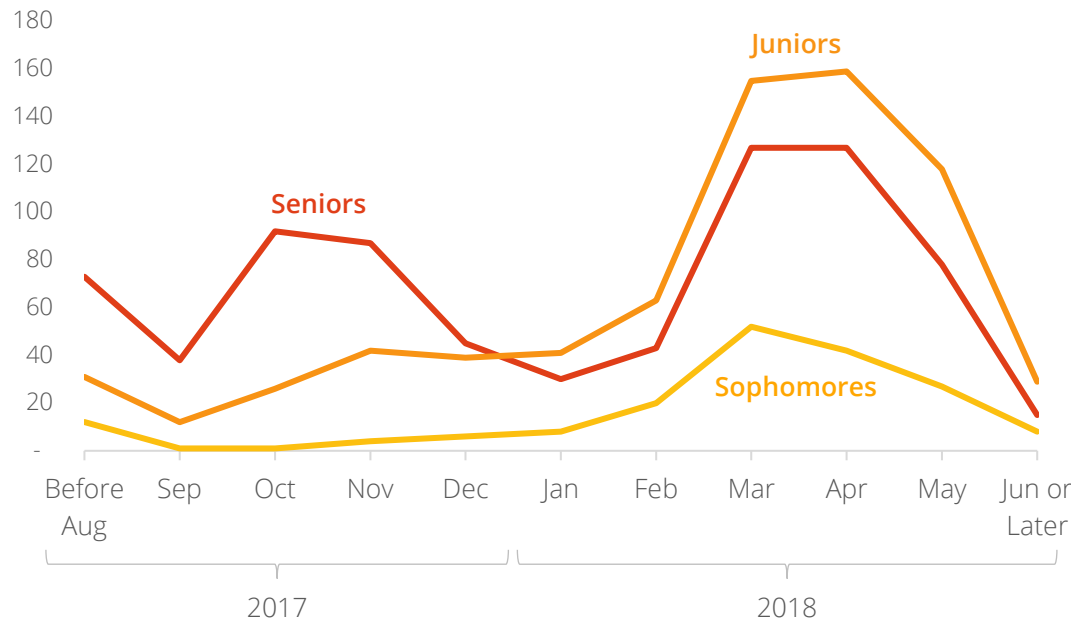

1,651 responses



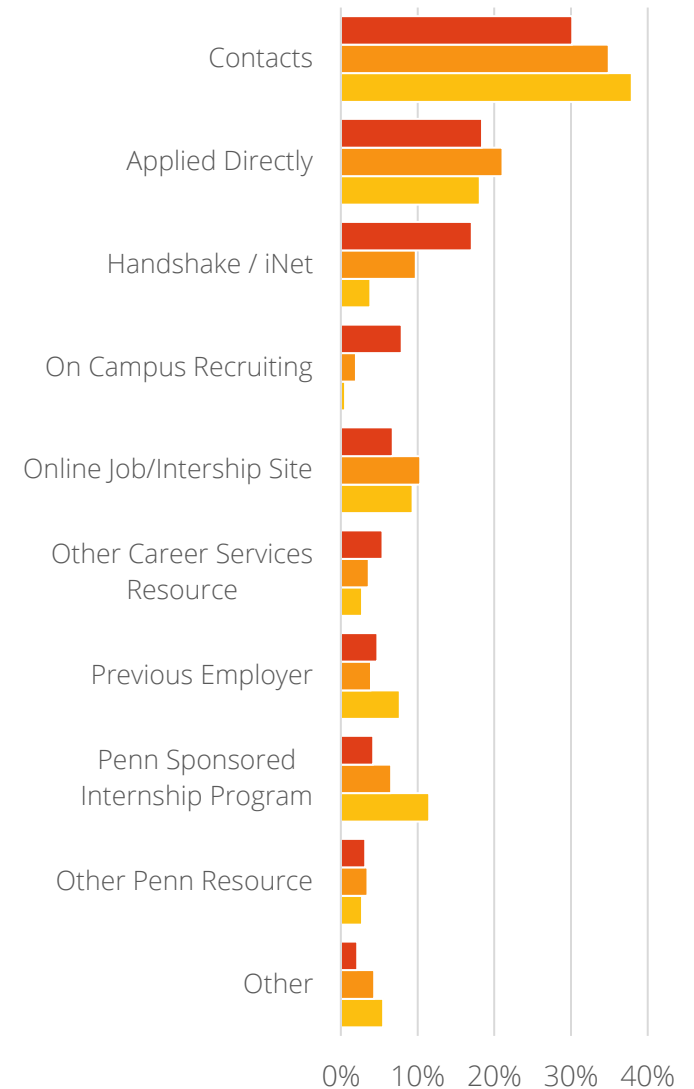
Rising Seniors primarily received offers in two groups: **22%** in the fall between October-November and **44%** in the spring between March-May.

Rising Juniors primarily received their offers in the spring: **60%** received their offers between March-May.

Rising Sophomores offers were even more condensed in the spring: **67%** received their offers in March-May.

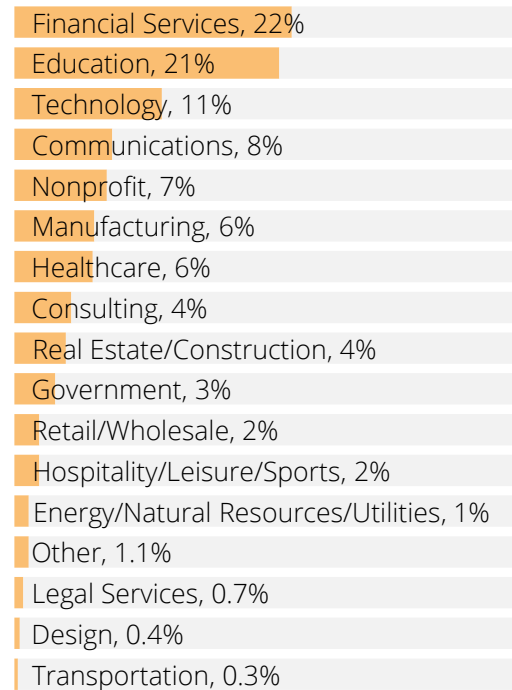

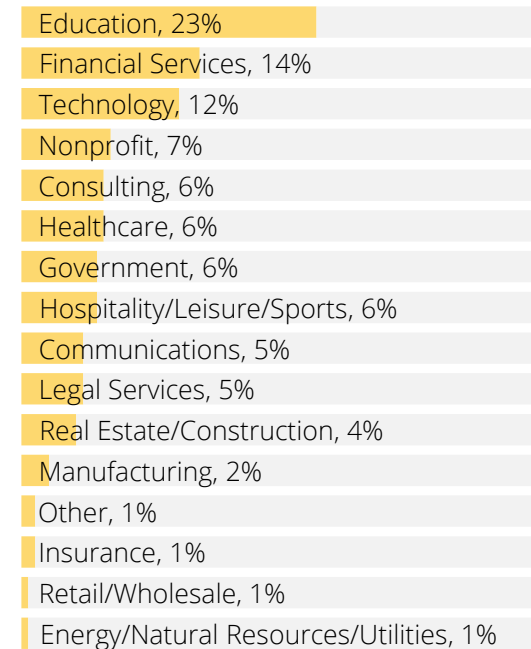
