



Methodology

Career Services at the University of Pennsylvania annually surveys graduating students to provide a snapshot of their post-graduation plans.

This report looks at the 610 The Wharton School undergraduates who received their degrees from August 2021–May 2022. Students were surveyed through September 30th, 2022 with a 67% response rate. Additional information was collected via LinkedIn and other sources, bringing the total **knowledge rate** up to **79%**, a total of 481 known graduate outcomes.



Known Outcomes 481 responses














Full-Time Employment


Employment by Job Function






Full-Time Employment





Most Impactful Strategy Leading to Offer



The primary method for obtaining the full-time employment offer that graduates accepted.

46% accepted return offers from a summer internship/previous employer, primarily in the **Financial Services** industry.

24% accepted offers from **On Campus Interviews** (through a summer internship/previous employer or through On Campus Interviews directly).

15% heard about the opportunity through **word of mouth** (from a connection at or outside of Penn).

Many employers hiring 2022 graduates had significantly increased their base starting salaries (primarily in **Financial Services** and **Consulting**) due to market conditions, resulting in an unusually high jump in average & median salaries.


