- Identify effective approaches for finding internships. Discuss the on-campus interviewing program and find out if employers you're interested in are coming to campus





Collect Information & Start Experiential Learning

- Attend Career-sponsored events held throughout the year, including the Annual Career & Internship Fair, industry-specific discussions and opportunities to network with alumni
- Have conversations and conduct informational interviews with professors, advisors, upper classmen, alumni, and industry professionals that are knowledgeable in your areas of interest
- Job shadow someone who works in your industry of interest
- Research and apply for summer internships, jobs, research, or volunteer opportunities
