Statement of Purpose

What problem are you trying to solve? What issues does this project address? What is the context for this project?

Research Question and/or Hypothesis

What questions are you trying to answer? What variables are you considering? What is the scope of the project?

Characteristics of a Successful Proposal (Validity) – Present a sound question or hypothesis that is well-defined in scope and will produce clear, measurable outcomes.

Significance of Research

How will your research contribute to the field? What is unique about your research? What is your research building upon?

Characteristics of a Successful Proposal (Significance) – Describe how your project will address a critical problem, benefit society or a community, or fill a gap in scholarship.

Methods of Data Collection

What frameworks or theories guide data collection? What processes or protocols need to be implemented for collection? What will be the source of your data?

⚠ Characteristics of a Successful Proposal (Reliability) — Describe appropriate methods for your research topic and include steps in work that are logical and complete.

Analysis of Data

How will you analyze the data to answer your research question and/or test your hypothesis? What processes or protocols need to be implemented for analysis?

Benchmarks

What benchmarks will you meet to complete the project? How will you share findings or progress about your project?
