ATS

The Applicant Tracking System, or ATS, refers to software that hiring managers use to weed out resumes that don't fit the parameters of the job description

Applicants should identify industry or position-specific words or phrases that will help their resume make it past the first stage of application

Buzzwords vs. Keywords

Remove jargon, especially if you are targeting a new industry

Don't Tell Me What You Did...



Created and developed 4th grade Science curriculum for the district in alignment with pedagogy best practices which motivated teachers to integrate science with content areas and was adopted by the district contributing to the increase of district performance in Science by 10%.
